



1. Use an appropriate text as a starting point. ('Doctor' it to meet the needs of the children and include the grammar and vocab required in teaching)
2. Teach (approximately) 6 fiction and 4 non-fiction per year.
3. Have your illustrated text on display on your 'washing line' at all times throughout the unit. (One per class)
4. Non-fiction should come out of an aspect of the fiction unit.
5. Teachers and support staff must model the Nelson Handwriting font.



6. ALL teachers, support staff and children must know the model text with actions BY HEART.
7. Sentence and word level work to be displayed on the working wall.
8. A4 books will be used across school. One English book for all work.
9. The teacher must model the writing i.e. actually writes the paragraph in the agreed font.
10. Hot and cold 'writes' to sandwich each unit in English books.
